The committee had its first meeting last month, and the ideas were flowing. Employee input was welcome, and no idea was too small for consideration. Some of the ideas discussed were how to reuse packaging materials, planting more shrubbery that will attract butterflies and bees, using environmentally friendly soaps and cleaning supplies, installing motion detectors for the indoor/outdoor lighting and defaulting printers to print double sided. The list goes on and on.


