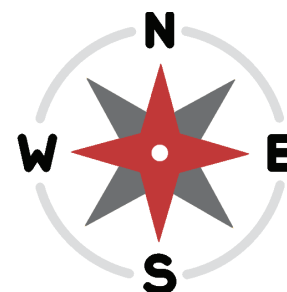

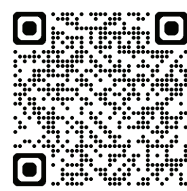

Ever clicked on a shocking headline only to realize the article had nothing to do with what it promised? That's clickbait—and it's not just annoying, it can be dangerous. Cybercriminals use it to spread false information, stir emotions, or trick people into clicking malicious links.

Lots of Sneaky Types of Disinformation Out There

- **Fabricated Content:** Pure fiction designed to mislead.
- **Manipulated Content:** Images or videos that have been edited to distort the truth.
- **Imposter Content:** Posts that pretend to come from a trustworthy source (like a fake news outlet or government agency).
- **Misleading Content:** Real information twisted or presented out of context.
- **False Context:** Combining truth with lies to make the fake parts seem believable.
- **Satire or Parody:** Meant to be funny—but not everyone realizes it's a joke!

How You Can Stay Safe

- **Check the Source:** Look for reliable authors and publications. If it's a site you've never heard of—or one that hides its contact info—be cautious.
- **Fact-Check:** Cross-reference stories on multiple reputable sites. Use third-party fact-checking services to confirm what you read.
- **Pause Before Sharing:** If something makes you angry or scared, that's a red flag—it might be designed to provoke you.

Wild New Tech Delivers All the Flavor with None of the Calories

Researchers at City University of Hong Kong have cooked up something truly extraordinary—virtual flavor! Their latest innovation brings taste to the digital world, adding a whole new "sense" to virtual reality experiences. Using a small handheld gadget that resembles a disposable vape pen, users can "taste" digital flavors through a process called iontophoresis. This technique uses mild electrical currents to deliver tiny ions to the tongue, simulating real flavors like sweet, sour, salty, or bitter—all without consuming a single calorie.

Imagine sampling a slice of virtual pizza while playing a VR cooking game or sipping a digital latte during an online meeting. This technology could one day make such experiences feel remarkably lifelike. Researchers believe it could also have applications in healthcare, allowing patients on restricted diets to safely enjoy virtual versions of their favorite foods, or even be used in culinary education and digital marketing.
